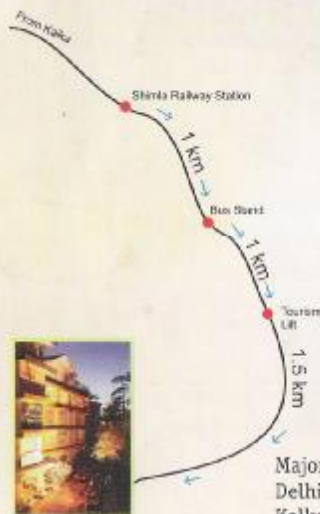

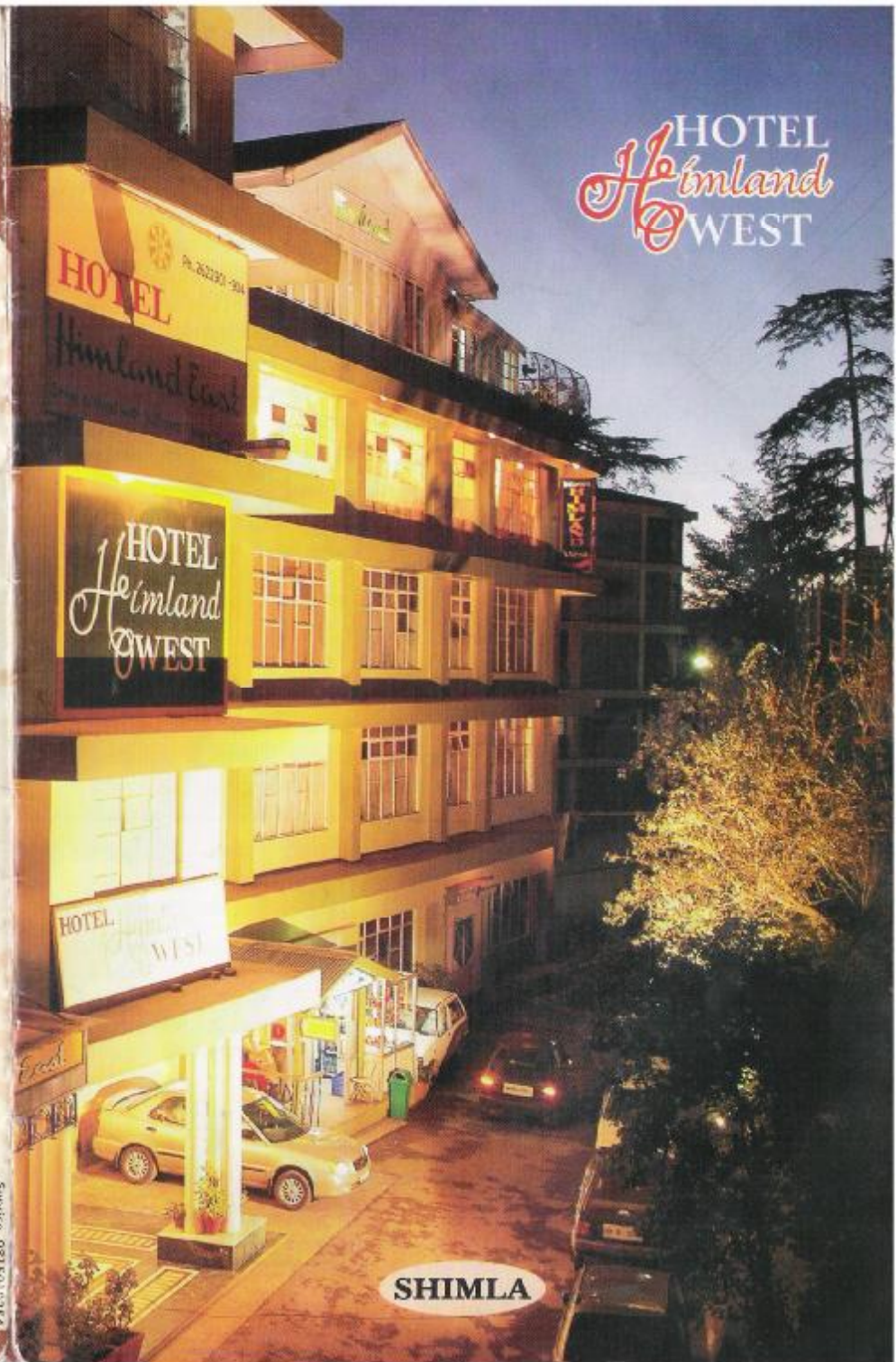

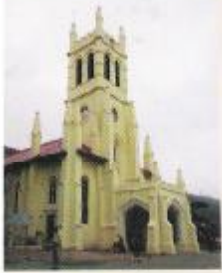

SHIMLA TOURIST PLACES

Visit Shimla anytime during the year, its forever beautiful. But it surely gets an added charm during the monsoons when the hills turn lush green. Winters too make it brilliant as soft snow covers the land and makes it shine pristine white. Ancient temples and old churches are worth visiting. Stop at one of the hills and find mist enveloping you and everything else around.

Shimla has the only natural ice-skating rink in India. An Ice-skating Carnival is arranged every year by the Ice-skating Club during January. During this festival, members display their skill on ice and participate in a fancy dress competition.



SHIMLA RELIGIOUS PLACES

Christ Church & St. Michael's Cathedral :

This famous landmark church of Shimla was built over a span of 11 years (1846-1857) and its the second oldest church of northern India. The beauty of the church is enhanced by the stained glass in its windows. The building looks all the more beautiful at night when its grand architecture glows with clever lighting. Another important church in Shimla is the Church of St. Michael's Cathedral.



Jakhoo Temple :

Dedicated to Lord Hanuman, this temple is at an altitude of 8048 feet above sea level and is the highest point of Shimla. It offers a panoramic view over the surrounding valley.



Sankat Mochan :

The famous "Lord Hanuman" temple is Situated on Ambala Shimla highway 5 Kms short of Shimla It commands an excellent view of Shimla town. Temple has beautiful campus and Langar is held every Sunday.



Kali Bari :

The temple is situated near to The Mall The temple is dedicated to Shyamala Devi (Shimla is named after this goddess), an incarnation of Goddess Kali.



Tara Devi :

11 km from the Shimla bus-stand. Tara Devi has a temple dedicated to the goddess of stars on top of the hill. There is a military Dairy Town here as well as the headquarters of Bharat Scouts and Guides. At a height of 6,070 ft, Tara Devi is an ideal place for a person wanting peace and some rest.



The Ridge :

The large open space in the heart of town presents excellent view of the mountain ranges.

MAIN TOURIST SPOTS

Himachal State Museum & Library :

Around two and a half kilometers from Scandal Point is Himachal State Museum and Library. The museum displays a collection of historical sculptors, paintings, coins and photos relating to the history of entire state. The museum itself is housed in a colonial building perched over hill top. The gallery also has an exquisite collection of paintings which are the last pieces of the Indian art form, the Pahari miniature art form before the Western form took over. There are dozens of Mughal and Rajasthani miniature paintings. The museum opens daily except on Mondays and public holidays.



The Mall :

The hub of Shimla is the Mall, which runs along the Ridge and is crowded with tourists. It is the city's most famous shopping center, with shops selling all items, from clothes to junk food. Most of Shimla's landmarks are located here. The Mall further joins the Ridge at the 'Scandal Point' , where a statue of Lala Lajpat Rai has been erected. This is the main shopping center of Shimla with restaurants



Glenn :

Its about 4 km walk from the Ridge through dense Forests, a sprightly stream flows through the Glen forests a It is a famous picnicspot.



Annandale :

Developed as the playground of Shimla, Annandale is 2-4 km from the Ridge at a height of 6,117 ft. It is a favourite spot for cricket, picnics and the princely game of polo.The Annandale polo field, It also acts as a Helipad when required.



Viceregal Lodge & Botanical Gardens :

On the Observatory Hills is located Viceregal Lodge. This magnificent building was the residence of the British Viceroy Lord Duffer in. The lodge has now been converted into Indian Institute of Advanced Studies and is a km further from the State Museum.

**Chadwick Falls :**

These are the 67 meters high water falls which come streaming down from the Summer Hill. The falls are set amidst thick forest at a height of 1586 meters. The falls are at their best after monsoons. You can go and explore the tracks in the forest on your own, deodar trees line the forest. There are also some old temples close by and a fair is held here in April every year.

**Seven Hills in Shimla :**

Shimla is surrounded by seven picturesque hills which are the prime attractions of city tours. These are :

1. Jakhoo hill in central Shimla, which is crowned by the temple indicated to Lord Hanuman.
2. Bantony in central Shimla, which has the Grand Hotel.
3. Prospect Hill : Famous for Kamna Devi temple.
4. Summer Hill : Here Himachal Pradesh University campus is located.
5. Observatory Hill : Famous for Indian Institute of Advanced Study.
6. Invererarm Hill : The hill top has the State Museum and TV broadcast tower.
7. Elysium Hill : This holds The Auckland House and Longwood and reaches out towards Bharari

**Kufri :**

16 km from Shimla at a height of 8,600 ft, Kufri is the winter sports capital. During winter, visitors have the facility for skiing. The skiing season is at its best during January and February. Equipment for sking is available from HPTDC winter sports club at Kufri. Apart from skiing, Kufri is a lovely picnic spot with a beautiful view of the hills around and the snowy peaks. There is also a zoo that delights children.

**Chharabra :**

13 km from Shimla on route to Kufri. Easy accessibility and beautiful scenery makes it a popular tourist place.

**Mashobra :**

13 km away from Shimla, Mashobra has several excellent picnic spots. Mashobra is the site of the annual Sipi fair in June. The nearest rest house is at Carignano which is 3 km from Mashobra, and is a beautiful holiday resort.

**Naldehra :**

22 km from Shimla and surrounded by beautiful deodar trees. Naldehra has a well kept nine-hole golf-course. It is a lovely, popular picnic spot. The annual sipi fair is held at seepur near mashobra.

**Tatapani :**

Another tourist place where you can find the sulphur springs which are found near the Tatapani mandir(holy temple).

**Chail :**

Chail is a little mountainous heaven 45 km from Shimla. It was the summer capital of the Maharaja of Patiala before Independence. The forests near Chail have many species of birds and deer. Chail is known for its cricket pitch, which is the highest cricket ground in the world.
